Topic 1 "Uniformity of Process" (page 63)

- *1795 Birth of modern Geology
- *James Hutton "The present is the key to the past."

*Uniformitarianism

- 1. The geologic processes now at work were also active in the past.
- 2. The present physical features of the Earth were formed by these same processes, at work over a long period of time.

Example: a canyon not formed from a sudden splitting catastrophe, instead, a river slowly wore away the land – and it is still happening

Topic 2 "Three Rock Groups" (page 63)

- *Rock A group of minerals bound together
- 1. *Igneous Rocks* Formed by the cooling and hardening of hot molten rock from inside the Earth
- 2. *Sedimentary Rocks* Formed by the compacting and cementing of layers of sediments (rock fragments, minerals, bio remains)
- 3. *Metamorphic Rocks* Formed when existing rocks are changed by heat and pressure
